SSTM September “Festival of Lay Involvement”



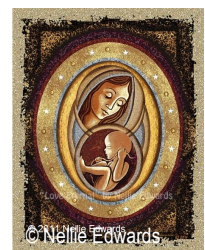
September 24-25, Respect Life and Legislative Advocacy and Gabriel Project Ministries participated in the SSTM ministry fair named Festival of Lay Involvement with displays in the narthex. All were invited. The narthex was crowded with ministries all vying for attention at the same time. Respect Life offered handouts including our then-new "Mother of Life" prayer cards, Spiritual Adoption prayer cards, lists of October and November opportunities for volunteers, and more.

The **Spiritual Adoption** prayer cards were well received and planted intended seeds of interest.

We will soon submit an evaluation form to the organizers and will offer suggestions for improving results at such ministry fairs in the future.

Spiritual Adoptions

The Spiritual Adoption Program is in its second month. A narthex easel displays progressing fetal development and a companion board displays parishioner participation. Once each month Lisa writes a bulletin notice with a picture and description of development. Nellie Edwards has granted permission to use her "Love Eternal" (shown here) in such a Spiritual Adoption bulletin notice.



Lisa will meet with Deacon Carl next week to complete a Charter Document for the Spiritual Adoptions program to include in St. Stephen (SSTM) parish records.

Lisa will talk with Kim to coordinate a May Pregnancy Aid baby shower with an all-parish Social (maybe a potluck).

Innocent Lives and Truth on the November Ballot

Many Catholics need reminding that Catholic moral Teaching insists that human Life issues be given the

highest priority, that Truth demands recognizing that marriage (possible only between one man and one woman) is essential to maintain a civilized society, and that religious freedom must be preserved, etc. We asked our SSTM clergy to speak to these teachings in their homilies during at least three of the five weekends of October, pro-life month, because **Church Teaching compels all adult Catholic U.S. citizens to VOTE according to Catholic Doctrine.**

- We will resume study of "**Theology of the Body**" next meeting. We have read "The Pope's Thesis," the first section describing St. John Paul II's revolutionary concept of using the visible mystery of man and woman's sexuality as a sign to the invisible mystery hidden in God.
