A **Jericho Walk** opened our 40 days of prayer on Ash Wednesday, March 1st. 16 walked with us on Day 7 (approximately 25% of 2016 participation).

Saturday, April 8th, an **8:30pm Candlelight Vigil at Kent Planned Parenthood** closes the 40 days of prayer vigils. <https://ststephenslife.com/documents/2017/3/closing2017v3.pdf> is the same flyer that was an SSTM April 2nd bulletin insert. Father Ed led 13 in prayer during the closing vigil.

This year's number of participants who signed up to stand hour-long vigils was less than in 2016. Passers-by let us know we were noticed, but there is little, if any, opportunity to interact with Planned Parenthood clients who enter by the front door to the building.

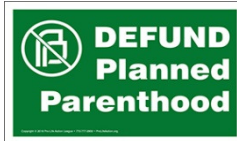

We counted only **30 pro-life** friends at the **February 11th** national Defund Planned Parenthood Day rally in Kent. As reported in photos and text at www.kentreporter.com/news/hundreds-attend-rallies-for-against-planned-parenthood-in-kent/?utm_source=hootsuite&utm_medium=social&utm_campaign=socialmedia **ten times our number reacted to our message and came to protest it.**

We are asking Father Ed to help us bring at least 100 parishioners from St. Stephen and 100 from each of our neighboring parishes to the April 29th event. We will invite our friends from other areas to join us, the Eastside Pro-Life, the North Seattle Pro-Life parishes, and 40 Days for Life Tacoma. In addition, Gina suggests all extend personal invitations to friends.

Spiritual Adoptions

The Spiritual Adoptions promotion begun last fall will conclude with a May ACCW drive to “shower” Pregnancy Aid with baby items to be collected at St. Stephen’s in May. Respect Life Ministry will buy the cake and help ACCW serve it with coffee after Masses May 27-28.



Gina, Lisa, and Kathleen plan games for families that will earn on-the-spot prizes of pieces of candy or little pro-life items for correct answers to game questions.

We have asked Father Ed’s approval and will seek his advice before ordering enough **Human Life Alliance (HLA) “Life Begins” comic books** (preview at <https://www.humanlife.org/product/life-begins/>) for all SSTM families with youngsters or grandchildren. Distributing these on the May 27-28 weekend may be good.
