Our meeting opened with St. John Paul II's prayer to Our Lady of Guadalupe, Mother of Life Prayer.

Rudy and his prayer partner, Bob, witnessed **a baby saved Friday, April 21st**! As they exited Renton Cedar River Clinics, a mother and her very young pregnant teenager stopped to tell the prayer team they "didn't do it," after driving from Portland for an abortion. Praise the Lord!

Two Feb. 11th Pacific Northwest participants are absent from the www.protestpp.com list of April 29th participants.

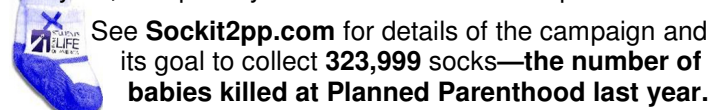
We participated April 29th, numbering 45 strong from 15 different churches/parishes (13 Catholic). See photos on the left at <http://ststephenslife.com/respect-life>

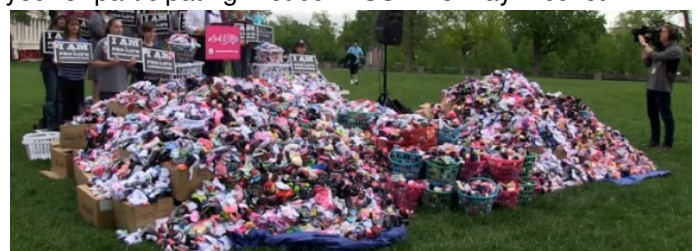

delivered nearly 200,000 baby socks, weighing more than two tons, with accompanying notes to Congress on April 28th. Even though the number of socks pictured is less than 2/3 the number of babies aborted by Planned Parenthood last year, the quantity makes obvious visual impact.

The signed notes to Congress demand no tax dollars go to Planned Parenthood. With a goal of 324, we collected 159 signed notes, 91 with socks, at SSTM. Spiritual Adoptions



The Spiritual Adoptions promotion begun last fall concludes with an **ACCW drive to “shower” Pregnancy Aid with baby items collected at St. Stephen’s** in May. Respect Life Ministry will buy the **cake** and help ACCW serve it **with coffee in the narthex after Masses May 27-28**.

One or two decorated sheet cakes will be served after each of the four Sunday Masses (including Saturday Vigil Mass).

RLM’s Spiritual Adoptions Team, Lisa, Gina, and Kathleen, and CCW plan decorating, prizes of “little” pro-life items for families to earn as rewards for correct answers to game questions. RLM provides little prizes, pro-life magnets, etc. Pending Father Ed’s approval, RLM will obtain 1,000 Human Life Alliance (HLA) “Life Begins” comic books (preview at <https://www.humanlife.org/product/life-begins/>) to offer to SSTM families with youngsters or grandchildren.

ACCW will have a bassinette to collect baby items and special containers for monetary donations to Pregnancy Aid.

RLM will display fetal model sets and also take pre-paid **orders** for Nellie Edwards **11” x 14” Mother of Life prints**.

The **handmade baby blankets by the Prayer Shawl Ministry** for Pregnancy Aid of Kent will be on display too.

Legislative Update

Washington State Legislature bills affecting parental notification, mandated contraceptive medical insurance, end-of-life issues, and more that weren’t brought to the floor for votes in the regular 2017 session, have opportunity for re-introduction during the current special session. We look to Family Policy Institute of Washington (FPIW) to provide status and, when necessary, call us to action to contact our legislators. Watch www.fpiw.org for updates on status of legislation impacting Life, families, and religious liberty.

Initiative #1552 (<https://justwantprivacy.org/>) will be on ballots only if 330,000 signatures are gathered before July.

Miscellaneous

- One of our new members, Brian, offered to buy 100 copies of Catholic Answers author Trent Horn’s pro-life book to distribute to people questioning why we pray on the sidewalk outside abortion mills.
- The newly formed SSTM **Social and Human Concerns Commission** wants to promote prayer, participation, and exposure of parishioners to parish groups, including Respect Life Ministry, by highlighting who we are and how we serve. In order to help the Commission prepare a proposal to submit to Father Ed, we responded to the commission’s inquiry. Our member Ron has agreed to

represent us to the Commission and will keep us apprised of Commission-proposed opportunity to promote and recruit interest in our Ministry.

- In celebration of the **50th anniversary of SSTM** involvement with **ACCW**, a new **Lady of Good Counsel icon** was blessed during a special **6:30 Mass April 26th**, Sacramental brought for blessing and some of our new banners were blessed too.
- **First Friday Movie & Food nights** will resume in 2017 (maybe in June) so we can preview pro-life videos, etc.
- After years of anticipation and preparation, **Wellness for Washington Women Clinic** www.3wmedical.org is operating and will have an open house May 20th.
- We will donate \$100 to Next Step’s annual June 17th fundraising auction <https://angelorum.org/wp/>
- Kathleen suggested we set our alarms to a chosen time of day to synchronize a brief prayer for Life each day.
- We are investigating ordering more Respect Life T-shirts
- Mary K proposes we produce a set of prayer cards for our ministry, similar to our 2016 “Mother of Life” cards. The new card will have a prayer that reflects our mission. What do we want this, our own prayer, to be?
