Frequently Asked Questions

Cedar River Clinics (CRC) abortion facility is located inside the Cascade Crest Building, 263 Rainier S., and shares its driveway with Pizza Hut and Midas Muffler, with only one entrance/exit onto Rainier Ave. S.

Where do I park?

Please do not park in front of Midas Muffler or in the Pizza Hut parking lot.

Taco Time has given permission for us to park in its lot, which is directly across Rainier Ave. from the abortion facility. The lot is larger than is required by the business. Taco Time asks us to park in the row(s) nearest Rainier Ave. Should the lot become crowded with Taco Time patrons, please move your car without delay.

On-street parking is allowed on SW Langston Road. Safeway has a large lot with entry from S 2nd or S 3rd.

Caution advises always take valuables with you and lock your vehicle before leaving it unattended.



Where do I stand?

Stand facing the clinic on the Rainier Ave. sidewalk in single file. Do not block foot traffic or visibility for vehicles exiting onto Rainier Ave. Never stand in the driveway. Street traffic is quite heavy so stay safe. You and your signs will face the vehicle traffic should you stand on the east side of Rainier while praying.

What if I'm the only one there to pray?

If you feel comfortable doing so, go ahead and get out of your car to pray; if not, feel free to stay inside your car and pray.

What prayers should I be saying?

See the prayers on the flip side of this sheet and, of course, the Rosary, Rosary, Rosary, as well as the Divine Mercy Chaplet. You can make up your own prayers or read your Bible, Stations of the Cross, or go to www.PriestsForLife.org and choose from the many prayers suggested there.

What if people approach me and want to start an argument?

Tell them you are there to pray for those inside the clinic and then ask if they'd like to join you in prayer.

What if someone comes out of the clinic after changing her mind?

If you are able to have a conversation with her, be loving and non-argumentative. The hotline number 1-800-395-HELP or 1-877-NOT-ALONE will offer options for where to go for help. OR you may suggest looking in the Yellow Pages under "Abortion Alternatives" or "Adoption." Ask your church's Lent for Life coordinator for pamphlets that have been ordered for this purpose.

May I bring my own signs?

We encourage using only signs with loving messages or Silent No More Awareness signs during Lenten vigils. During Lenten vigils, see your church's coordinator or Betty in St. Stephen's office (253.631.1940) to obtain an appropriate sign. You may keep the sign until the last Lenten prayer vigil.

What if I can't stand the whole time?

A camp stool might work but place it no more than two feet from the sidewalk; do NOT block the sidewalk.

IMPORTANT: This is a time for PRAYER rather than fellowship. Do not chat with your partner. Pray and pray for conversion and change of heart for abortionists, clinic staff, and parents of innocent victims.
